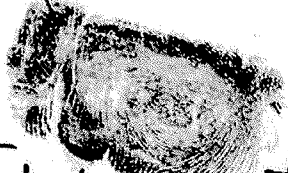

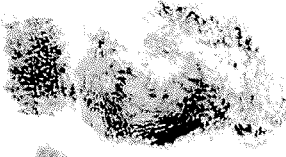

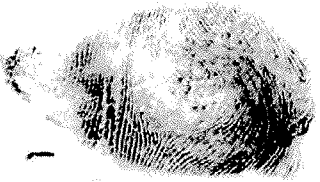

AND WHEREAS the Trustees have agreed to become trustees and to hold and apply the said sum of RS. 2 LAKHS (Two lakhs Only) and to give contributions subscription and donations for the said fund and for such purposes and subject to the Trustees' power and provisions contained in this Deed.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH that in pursuance of the aforesaid desire and for carrying out such desire into effect the Settlor do hereby grant, transfer and assign unto the said Trustees.

1. The Trustees shall stand possessed of the said sum of RS. 2 LAKHS (Two lakhs Only) and the profits and income there of stock, fund, securities, donations, contributions, subscriptions and amalgamations that may hereafter be collected by the Trustees under these presents and the properties movable and immovable for the time being representing the same respectively (hereinafter for brevity's sake called "the Trust Funds") upon the Trust and with and subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter declared and contained of and concerning the same, that is to say:-

a) Upon Trust in the first instance to collect the dividends, interests, rents, profits and other income of the Trust Funds (hereinafter for brevity's sake called 'the Income of the Trust Funds') and from and out of the same in the first place pay all the proper costs, charges and expenses of the Trust Funds and incidental to the collection thereof and all outgoing payable in respect of the Trust Funds and any

immovable property or properties for the time being subject to the Trusts hereof as also the costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the execution, management and administration of the trusts and power herein contained.

b) Subject to the provisions of sub-clause (a) of this clause, the Trustees shall hold the Trust funds upon trust (so that as far as practicable that corpus shall always remain intact and only the income thereof shall be used, but with liberty to the Trustees at their discretion to use the corpus from time to time either wholly or in part or parts) for the purposes specified in this trust including for

- i. Relief to the poor/deserving persons,
- ii. Advancement of education, establishment of good schools, colleges & other institute,
- iii. Medical Relief,
- iv. Advancement of any other object of general public utility as the Trustees may think fit and for one or more of such purposes to the exclusion of other or others as the capital as well as the corpus shall be applied only towards the purposes as aforesaid and any accumulation of income shall also be made and deemed to be made for application to such purposes as aforesaid **PROVIDED FURTHER:**

a) THAT notwithstanding anything hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, the income as also the corpus of the Trust Funds shall be applied and be applicable only to or for such purposes and objects and subject to such conditions or limitations if any as may from time to time be laid down in the Income-Tax Act 1962, or any other Act governing the taxation of income as well ensure or make the Trust hereby established and its income as eligible for exemption from taxation under the Income Tax Act 1961, or any replacement or re-enactment thereof or modification thereof or under any other Government taxation for the time being in force in India.

b) And further so that the Trust hereby established shall be one to which the provisions of section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any replacement re-enactment or the modification thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation thereto be recognized eligible for exemption or relief from Tax in regard to the Donor.

c) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing objects or purposes but subject as aforesaid **IT IS DECLARED** that the Trustees shall in each year apply the income of the Trust Funds and may at the discretion at any time and from time to time apply also the **TRUST FUNDS** or any part or parts of the Trust Funds in or towards any one or more of the

3) To hold examinations and to grant certificate of proficiency or other academic distinction or title to persons who have complied with the conditions laid down in the Regulations or by-laws of the Trust including Rules and Regulations of the State Govt. or any other statutory body set up by such Govt. including Rules and By-laws of **CISCE, CBSE, WEST BENGAL BOARD** of other Boards etc, as would be applicable depending upon the nature of Institute and its affiliation.

4) To provide libraries, reading rooms for the benefit of the studies and other persons for promoting education and social welfare.

5) Establishing, maintaining and/or granting aid to Institutions for the relief of the poor and advancement of the education and also for the purposes of aforesaid, also to deserving persons as the Trustees may think fit and proper.

6) To promote and establishing Institutes of physical culture body building, general public health improvement, physical health related education and improving the general health and physical development of students and other section of

35) To do social welfare and to propagate Indian Culture amongst the general public and to all acts, deeds and things as may be necessary for social welfare, harmony in community, educational development and other advancement and/or improvement of general public at large and for uplifting of their mental attitude.

36) To carry on any business for the benefit and for augmenting the Income of the Trust and to utilize the same for the object of the Trust and to do all acts, deeds and things as may expected to be done by the Management of the business.

37) Without distinction and irrespective of religion, casts or creed to give relief to poor, relief to the deserving, medical relief advancement and propagation of any object of general

VI. XIII. XV. The trustees shall be empowered to carry on any trade industry or exhibition which in the opinion of the trustees and subject to the provisions of Indian Income Tax Act 1961, Indian Trust Act 1882 for the time being in force are permissible and are essential, incidental or conducive to the attainment or for the fulfillment of all or any of the objects of the Trusts.

XVI. The number of Trustees of these presents shall not be less than two and more than six in numbers and the Trustees shall be entitled to appoint additional Trustee or Trustees as and when the Trustees unanimously decide the same by appropriate resolution. 
